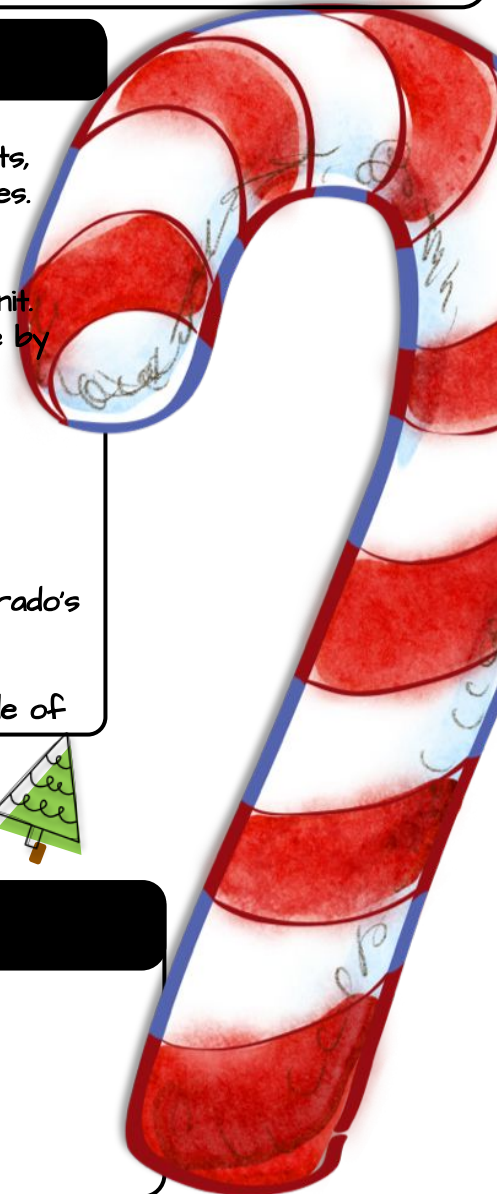
What we are learning:
