**Science:** We are approaching the end of our Organisms and Ecosystems unit, the relationships between and among living and nonliving components of ecosystems. We will begin our last unit of the year, the study of environments and living organisms through an investigation of fossils and rock layers.

**Social Studies:** We are in the middle of our Fur Trappers and Traders unit, studying the early economic pull factors that led people to settle in Colorado, leading us into our next unit this month, Settlements to Statehood, the early Colorado settlements and resulting cultural conflicts.

**Writing:** We are conducting short research projects to gather information from print and digital sources, taking notes, and categorizing information in order to write informative texts to examine a topic and convey ideas and information clearly; citing sources used.

**Math:** We are beginning Unit 6, focusing on the relationship between multiplication and division and the exploration of angles measures through the lens of using appropriate tools and making use of structure.
